Adding value to water

Water is available (even in deserts)

97.5% is salty or deep, 2.5% is fresh on surface


70% of the fresh surface water is ice or moisture

< 1% of all water is the accessible fresh water

> 90% of the accessible fresh water just passes, but > 90% of the passing water is now misused

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
Goals of sanitation
