

Two Proposals in the Making



HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-02-03: Development of smart concepts of integrated energy-driven bio-refineries for co-production of advanced biofuels, bio-chemicals, and biomaterials

The proposal under this <u>call</u> focuses on the development of advanced, integrated bio-refinery concepts powered by renewable energy for the simultaneous production of biofuels, bio-chemicals, and biomaterials. It aims to promote innovation in renewable energy systems to support sustainable energy and circular bioeconomy solutions.

The proposal, is due to be submitted 04 February 2025, the partners involved in the proposal from ESEIA members: TU Graz, Unizagreb-PBF, TU Vienna, LNEG. Project budget: € 3.5 Mil.

HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-02-10: Market Uptake Measures of renewable energy systems

The proposal under this <u>call</u> is dedicated to accelerating the market uptake of several specific renewable energy systems. It recognizes the societal and policy importance of this market uptake and the potential for general lessons from the examples in the proposals. This proposal's main expected impact is to ignite a more effective market uptake of renewable energy systems as envisioned in the European Strategic Energy Technology Plan (SET-Plan).

The deadline for submission is 04 February 2025. The proposal is coordinated by **Frans Coenen**, University of Twente, NL. The partners involved in this proposal include ESEIA and ESEIA members EASt, ADENE, UTBV, BAV, IERC, Utwente and Karelia UAS. Project budget: € 2 Mil.

At COP29 in Baku, the European Investment Bank Group (EIBG), the European Commission (EC), and the Solar Impulse Foundation (SIF) unveiled a new energy efficiency initiative aimed at accelerating decarbonization efforts for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).

This pilot initiative, part of the EIB Group Strategic Roadmap 2024-2027, focuses on supporting SMEs in overcoming barriers to energy-efficient investments, such as high upfront costs and limited resources.
